

Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

**Scheme annexed to Plans Nos. 60507694/C11/130 to 60507694/C11/133
under section 5 describing**

Tung Chung New Town Extension
(Road Works at Ying Hei Road and Tung Chung Waterfront Road)**

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60507694/C11/130 to 60507694/C11/133 (“the Plans”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to serve the anticipated traffic demand induced by the Tung Chung New Town Extension Project.

2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—
 - (i) construction of elevated covered walkways, elevated cycle tracks, pedestrian crossings, staircases, lifts, vertical noise barriers and cantilever noise barriers;
 - (ii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing at-grade carriageway to at-grade footpath, at-grade amenity area and column;
 - (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at-grade footpaths to at-grade cycle tracks, elevated cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas and columns;

- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at-grade cycle tracks to at-grade footpaths, at-grade amenity area and column;
- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at-grade amenity areas to at-grade carriageway, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, elevated cycle tracks and columns;
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing pedestrian crossings to central reserves;
- (vii) permanent closure and demolition of existing pedestrian crossings;
- (viii) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing at-grade footpaths;
- (ix) temporary closure of sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas and central reserves/refuge islands; and
- (x) ancillary works including landscaping, drainage, water, street lighting and utilities works, as well as installation of street furniture and traffic aids.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of the existing at-grade carriageway, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas and pedestrian crossings; and temporarily sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas and central reserves/refuge islands within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans. Temporary alternative access will be

provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas, pedestrian crossings and central reserves/refuge islands are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, stormwater drains, gas pipes and any other apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
