Amendments under section 7

General Description of the Proposed Amendments

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ("the Ordinance"), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to amend the works and the use originally shown on Plans Nos. 60507694/C11/100 and 60507694/C11/110 to 60507694/C11/120 ("the Plans") and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 3762 published under section 8(2) of the Ordinance on 25 May 2018 and 1 June 2018. The works and the use were authorized under section 11(1) of the Ordinance and the notice of authorization was published in G.N. 6886 on 14 September 2018 and 21 September 2018. The proposed amendments are shown on Amendment Plans 60507694/CS03/100 and 60507694/CS03/111 to 60507694/CS03/114 ("the Amendment Plans") annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed amendments are required to introduce underground cycle subways to the original scheme.

- 2. The general nature and extent of the proposed amendments are as follows:—
 - (i) construction of underground cycle subways, at grade footpath, at grade cycle track and at grade amenity area;
 - (ii) deletion of sections of the originally proposed at grade footpaths and replacement by proposed depressed cycle tracks, at grade cycle tracks and at grade amenity areas;
 - (iii) deletion of sections of the originally proposed at grade cycle tracks and replacement by proposed depressed cycle tracks, at grade footpaths and at grade amenity areas;
 - (iv) deletion of a section of the originally proposed cycle parking area and replacement by proposed at grade footpath and at grade amenity area;
 - (v) deletion of sections of the originally proposed at grade amenity areas and replacement by proposed depressed cycle tracks, at grade footpaths, at grade cycle tracks and cycle parking area;
 - (vi) temporary closure of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas; and
 - (vii) ancillary works including drainage and utilities works.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use for this amendment scheme, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas within the limit of works area as shown on the Amendment Plans. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary

diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths and amenity areas are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use for this amendment scheme, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, stormwater drains, sewerage pipes, district cooling system pipes, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
