

Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

Scheme annexed to Plans Nos. RD/GZ112 and RD/GZ113 under section 5 describing

PWP Item No. 7786CL Tung Chung New Town Extension (Road Works at Shun Tung Road)

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. RD/GZ112 and RD/GZ113 (“the Plans”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to serve the anticipated traffic demand induced by the Tung Chung New Town Extension Project.

2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—
 - (i) construction of pedestrian crossings;
 - (ii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at-grade carriageways into at-grade footpath and at-grade central reserves/traffic islands;
 - (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at-grade footpaths into at-grade carriageways and at-grade amenity area;
 - (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at-grade amenity areas into at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths and at-grade central reserve/traffic island;

- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing at-grade central reserves/traffic islands into at-grade carriageways and at-grade amenity areas;
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing staircase into at-grade footpath and slope;
- (vii) permanent closure and demolition of existing pedestrian crossings;
- (viii) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade amenity areas and at-grade central reserves/traffic islands;
- (ix) temporary closure of sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas, at-grade central reserves/traffic islands and staircase;
- (x) demolition and conversion of sections of the existing slopes into at-grade footpaths and staircase;
- (xi) demolition and reconstruction of sections of the existing slopes; and
- (xii) ancillary works including landscaping, drainage, water, street lighting and utilities works, construction of retaining walls and installation of street furniture and traffic aids.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade amenity areas, at-grade central reserves/traffic islands, staircase and pedestrian crossings; and temporarily sections of the existing at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas, at-grade central reserves/traffic islands and staircase within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be

carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such at-grade carriageways, at-grade footpaths, at-grade cycle tracks, at-grade amenity areas, at-grade central reserves/traffic islands, staircase and pedestrian crossings are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any gas, electricity, water or telecommunications service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, stormwater drains, sewerage pipes, gas pipes and any other apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
