### Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

# Scheme annexed to Plan No. RD/GZ009 under section 5 describing

## PWP Item No. 7786CL Tung Chung New Town Extension (Coastal Pedestrian Access)

#### General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ("the Ordinance"), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. RD/GZ009 ("the Plan") annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to serve the anticipated traffic demand induced by the Tung Chung New Town Extension Project.

- 2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows
  - (i) construction of sections of an at grade footpath and a section of an elevated footpath of approximately 240 metres long in total;
  - (ii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing amenity area into cycle parking place;
  - (iii) permanent closure and demolition of a section of the existing footpath;
  - (iv) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing footpath, cycle track and amenity area;
  - (v) temporary closure of sections of the existing footpath, cycle track and amenity area; and

(vi) ancillary works including site formation, landscaping, drainage, street lighting and utilities works, construction of retaining walls and slope, and installation of street furniture and traffic aids.

#### Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of the existing footpath and amenity area; and temporarily sections of the existing footpath, cycle track and amenity area within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such footpath, cycle track and amenity area are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

## Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any existing utility service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, stormwater drains, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be

altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
