Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

Scheme annexed to Plan No. RD/GZ004 under section 5 describing

PWP Item No. 7786CL Tung Chung New Town Extension (Widening of Tung Chung Road North)

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ("the Ordinance"), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. RD/GZ004 ("the Plan") annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to serve the anticipated traffic demand induced by the Tung Chung New Town Extension Project.

- 2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows
 - (i) widening of existing Tung Chung Road North to a single two-lane carriageway;
 - (ii) construction of carriageways with associated footpaths, cycle tracks, cycle parking place, amenity areas, run-ins/run-outs and pedestrian crossings;
 - (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, cycle tracks, amenity area and slopes;
 - (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways, cycle tracks, amenity areas and slope;

- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing amenity areas into footpath and slopes;
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing staircase into footpath and slopes;
- (vii) permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing carriageways, footpath and amenity area;
- (viii) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and staircase;
- (ix) temporary closure of sections of the existing carriageways, amenity area and staircase; and
- (x) ancillary works including site formation, landscaping, drainage, sewerage, water, street lighting and utilities works, construction of staircase, retaining walls and slopes, and installation of street furniture and traffic aids.

Land to be Resumed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 13 of the Ordinance may be exercised to resume the land as shown on Resumption Plan No. ISM2830a annexed hereto and detailed in the table set out thereon. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the land is to be resumed, will be issued under section 14 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Roads to be Closed

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently sections of

the existing carriageways, footpaths, amenity areas and staircase; and temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, amenity area and staircase within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths, amenity areas and staircase are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

5. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any existing utility service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, stormwater drains, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
