

LANDS RESUMPTION ORDINANCE (Chapter 124)
(Notice under section 4)

RESUMPTION OF LAND FOR
DEVELOPMENT AT TUNG CHUNG NEW TOWN EXTENSION,
FOR PUBLIC HOUSING DEVELOPMENT IN AREA 33, TUNG CHUNG

To the owners and every person interested or having any right or easement in all those pieces or parcels of land in the New Territories more particularly described below and shown coloured orange on the Resumption Plan No. ISM3299a:—

Lots Nos. 481, 482, 483 RP, 496 RP, 512 RP, 513, 514, 515, 516, 517, 518, 519, 520, 521 RP and 522 RP all in Demarcation District No. 3 Tung Chung.

TAKE NOTICE that the Chief Executive in Council has decided that the above-mentioned land is required for a public purpose, and under powers delegated by the Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, I have made an order that the above-mentioned land shall be resumed and revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region on the expiration of THREE MONTHS from the date of the affixing of this notice to the said land.

This notice was affixed to the above-mentioned land on 27 February 2025. Upon expiration of the notice period at midnight on 27 May 2025, the above-mentioned land shall revert to the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. The date of reversion shall be 28 May 2025.
